### Remembering Cpl Ben Nowak RM

On 12th Nov 2006 Cpl Ben Nowak, 27, from Speke, Liverpool, died whilst serving with 45 Cdo RM, as a result of injuries sustained following the detonation of an IED mounted on a bridge on the Shatt Al Arab River on the eastern edge of Basra City, Iraq. Other casualties that tragic day were, Marine Jason Hylton, 33, 539 ASRM, WO2 Lee Hopkins, 35, Royal Signals & SSgt Sharron Elliott, 34, Int Corps.

Ben Nowak, a proud Evertonian, made his Corps footballing debut on 9th Aug 2000 v Budleigh Salterton FC. I would describe Ben as a box to box midfielder who covered every blade of grass and didn't give opposing players time or space to play. Due to deployments and completing Junior Command Course & Physical Training Instructors course he would only make 2 further RMFA appearances playing his last Corps game on 21st Nov 2005 v Budleigh Salterton FC. I am in no doubt he would have racked up many more caps. Ben was remembered at the Premier League Everton v Bolton Wanderers game on 18th Nov 2006 in recognition of his time at Everton working with young players, which was attended by members of the Corps. In 2010 the RMFA played against a Ben Nowak XI at Everton FC's Finch Farm training ground. The Gym at 45 Cdo RM Condor Barracks is named 'The Ben Nowak Centre' in his honour. RIP Ben x


## Lifting The Lid Promoting Positive Mental Health
